Includes emergency food and toiletries pantry. Applicants must live within specified <u>service area</u> and may receive food eight times in twelve months. Must provide photo ID and proof of residency. Open Monday – Thursday 8:30am – 12:00pm for regular food distribution and Friday 8am – 12pm for seniors (60+) food distribution. Also provides emergency financial & education assistance, access to community programs, and wellness programs. Applications must be completed to gain access to services. Due to COVID-19, all applications for services are completed online.

Each person has access to basic needs, employment center, substance use recovery, and more.
