The dates of this report are August 14 – December 23, 2016.

Participation Information

- 240,195 participations
 - This counts each participant as many times as they used the facility.
 - This is a 1.26% (3,064) decrease in participations compared to Fall 2015 (243,259).
- 16,500 individual participants
 - This number indicates that 16,500 people used the facility 240,195 times.
- 15,764 individual students
 - This counts every enrolled student that used the facility. This number is subtracted from the individual participants above.
 - This indicates that 736 of the individual participants were not enrolled UNT students.
 - 42% of all UNT students used the Rec Center.

Characteristics of Student Users

- Of the 15,764 student users, 14,095 are enrolled full-time and 1,669 are enrolled part-time.
 - 49% of all full-time UNT students used the Rec Center.
 - 18% of part-time UNT students used the Rec Center.
- 8,399 student users are male (53%), and 7,365 are female (47%).
 - University of North Texas Student profile: 17,811 are male (47%), and 20,168 are female (53%).
- 71% of all Freshmen used the Rec Center, 50% of all Sophomores used the Rec Center, 40% of all Juniors used the Rec Center, and 33% of all Seniors used the Rec Center.
- 78% of First-Time-In-College students used the Rec Center.

Ethnicity of Student Users

- 41% of the student users were Caucasian, 17% of the student users were African-American, 24% of the student users were Hispanic, 8% of the student users were Asian American.
 - The facility had a higher percentage of African American, Hispanic, Asian, and Non-Resident students than UNT enrollment.
 - The facility had a lower percentage of Caucasian and American Indian students than UNT enrollment, and a similar percentage of Other students as UNT enrollment.

Residence of Student Users

- 31% of student users live in a Residence Hall, 19% live in Denton City, 8% live in Denton County (outside of Denton City) and 43% live outside of Denton County.
 - 79% of all UNT students who live in Residence Halls use the Rec Center.
 - 46% of all UNT students who live in the city of Denton use the Rec Center.

GPA of Student Users

- This compares the average GPA of the facilities' student users to the average GPA of the University non users. **For each classification level, the GPA of Rec Center users was higher than non-users.**
 - Freshmen: 2.72 Users, 2.45 Non-Users
 - Sophomores: 2.89 Users, 2.70 Non-Users
 - Juniors: 2.92 Users, 2.80 Non-Users
 - Seniors: 3.08 Users, 3.02 Non-Users
