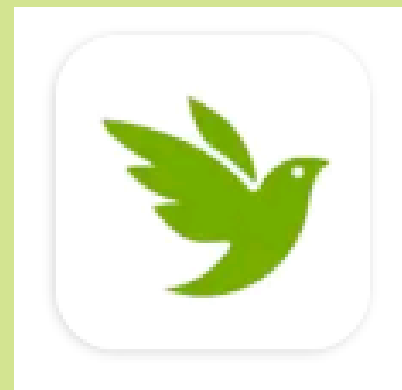

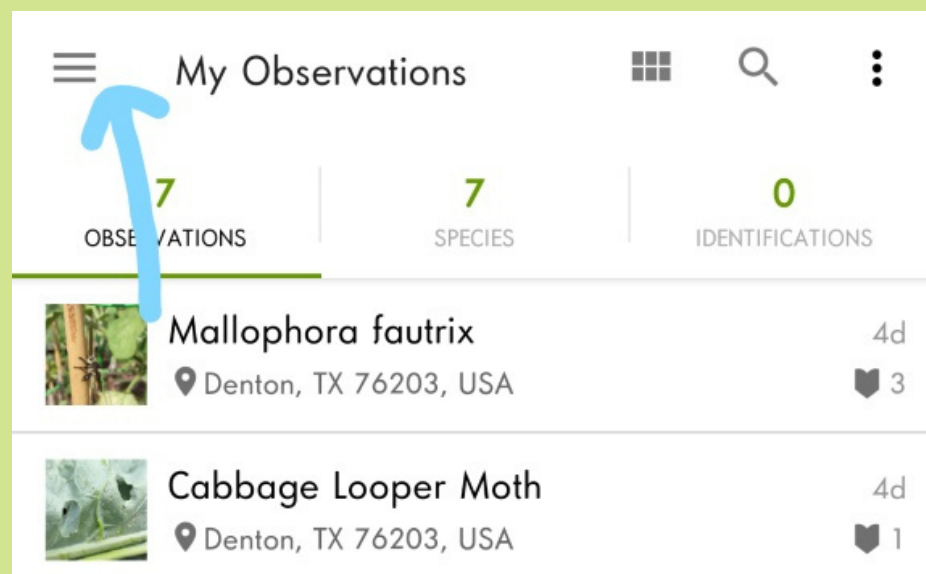
Download iNaturalist from the app store!

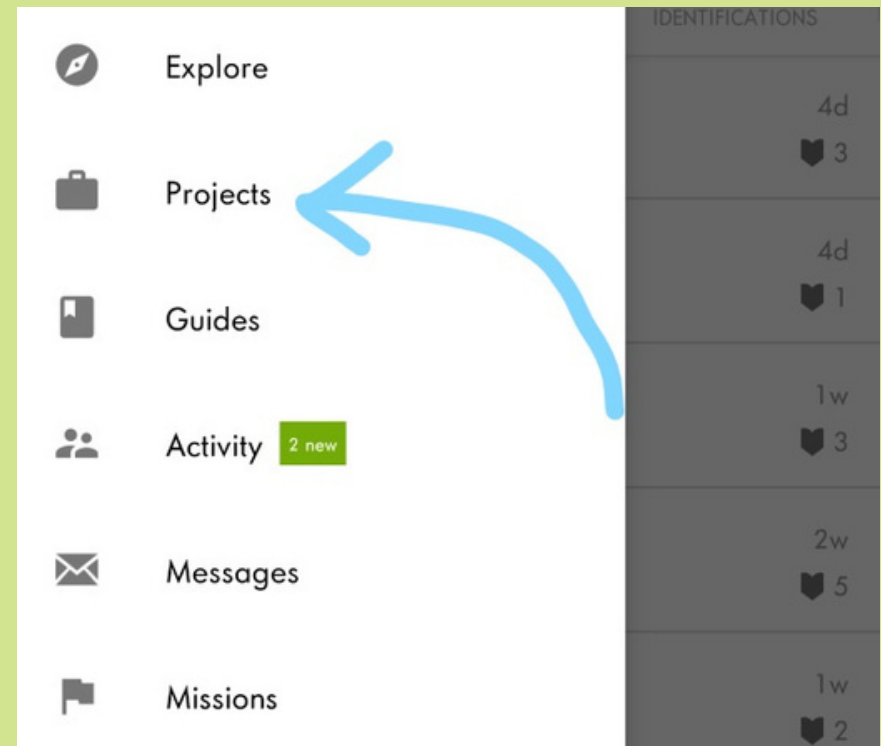
Open the menu on the top left corner of the screen.


You can also use the compare function to assist you in correctly identifying the species of your observation!



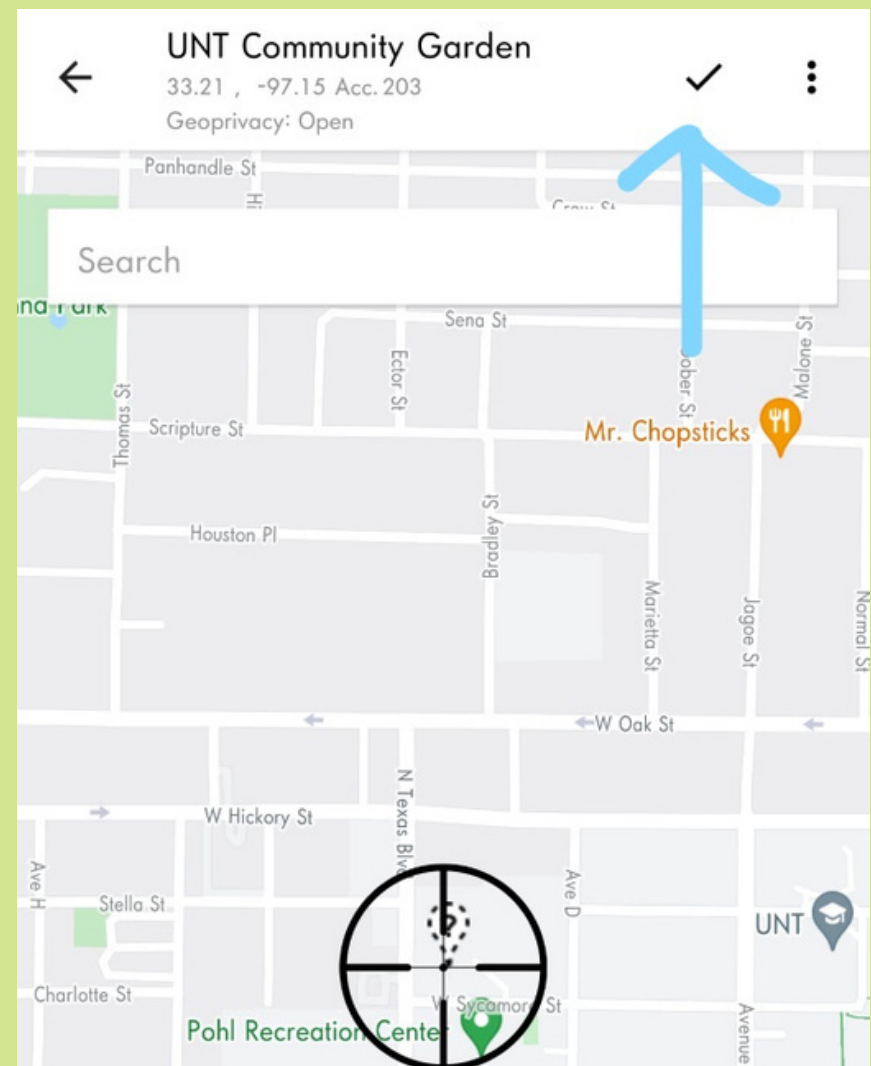

Captive/Cultivated?

The iNat app is used to collect data about *wildlife*. This app is not used to document captive animals or cultivated plants intentionally grown by humans. If you document a species that is not naturally occurring, make sure to select 'captive/cultivated' on the observation details.
