Constitutional Amendments

Do you support amending Article III (Composition of the Association) of the SGA Constitution to replace this current clause: B) No member of the Executive Branch shall serve concurrently in any other branch of the SGA with the following: B) No member currently serving in a branch of the SGA shall hold concurrent active membership in any other branch of the SGA.

Yes – 765 (87%)

No – 114 (13%)

Do you support amending Article III (Composition of the Association) of the SGA Constitution to add the following clause: C) Positions may be created for any purpose which aren't expressly provided for in the Constitution of the SGA by appropriate active members of the SGA. These positions must fall within the branch of the active member creating the position. No active member may create a position in a branch of which that person is not a member.

Yes – 769 (89%)

No – 92 (11%)

Do you support amending Article III (Composition of the Association) of the SGA Constitution to add the following clauses: D) The Executive Branch shall be tasked with maintaining a running and accurate list of active positions within the SGA and their identification with the enumerated branches of the SGA. E) This list will be readily available on the SGA website.

Do you support amending Article VI (The Judicial Branch), Section 2 (Composition of the Supreme Court) of the SGA Constitution to add the following clause: C) Supreme Court Justices shall not perform work or actions that are not strictly within the parameters of their duties as defined in this article.

Summary of Election Compliant Decisions

April 8, 2021

On April 7, 2021, Jackson Sweet submitted a formal complaint against Devon Skinner and David Munoz-Sarabia claiming a violation of Article 5, Section 1, Item A stating that the Skinner/ Munoz-Sarabia campaign violated the Election Code by having campaign material within Campus Housing.

Parties Present: Ivalis Guajardo, Daniel Ojo, Will Bodnar, Amanda Zimmerman, Lazayvion Hammick, and Kennedy Montgomery

Alleged Violation: The Skinner/Muñoz-Sarabia campaign has put up campaign flyers in several Campus Housing buildings, including Honors Hall, West Hall, and Rawlins Hall. This is in direct violation of Election Code Article V, Section 4, Subsection A, Clause (b), which state “Candidates and Referendum Parties shall not campaign or display in any manner campaign material within fifty (50) feet of restricted zones. The following areas and buildings are off limits to during campaigning; Campus Housing.

Article 5, Section 4. Restrictions on Special Buildings and Areas

- A. Candidates and Referendum Parties shall not campaign or display in any manner campaign material within fifty (50) feet of restricted zones. The following areas and buildings are off limits to during campaigning;
 - a. The SGA Office--any materials that are campaign related may not be stored or left in the SGA Office.
 - b. Campus Housing--all campaigning or campaign material in or on the property of UNT Housing requires the expressed consent of the Director of UNT Housing & Residence life or designee, and must abide by UNT Housing policies. Door-to-door campaigning shall not be permitted under any circumstances.**

Decision: Through a unanimous vote, the SGA Election Board decided there was not an Election Code Violation as Devon Skinner was able to provide over five emails with approval from Gina Vanacore, the Executive Director of Housing and Residence Life Administration.
