Requires a government ID, photo ID, copy of current lease or mortgage, copy of all household bills, proof of all income including benefits, and documentation of crisis – bills, medical, etc. to determine eligibility.*

Residents also attend classes and meet with their caseworker 1 on 1. Intake interviews are done on Tuesdays and Thursdays 9:00am-1:30pm and Sundays 9:00am-1:00pm.*
