Open Monday – Friday and the first and third Saturday, 9am – 3pm. Also provides emergency financial & education assistance, access to community programs, and wellness programs.

AUSTIN STREET CENTER

Provides an emergency, overnight shelter for men, ages 45 and older, and women, ages 18 and older, experiencing homelessness. Women's intake: 2 p.m. Monday-Saturday, 11 a.m. Sunday. Men's intake: 4 p.m. Monday-Saturday, 2 p.m. Sunday. Must provide a valid state or government ID, guests are allowed a maximum of 2 bags, max weight 25 lbs. each. Each person has access to basic needs, employment center, substance use recovery, and more.
