3. Senator Mercado change "recent executive order" to "current political climate". Seconded by Senator Alvarado.
 - a. Voted by roll call. Passed.
4. Senator Sanders motions to include "political", before "actions that target".
 - a. Voted on by roll call. Failed.
5. Senator Miller proposed to change "stands against any political or discriminatory actions that target"
 - a. Senator Belokin motions to vote by roll call.
 - i. Voted by roll call. Passes.



6. Senator Sven moved to change 5th amendment to remove “recent executive order” and include “affected by the current climate”
7. Senator Ramirez motions to vote by unanimous consent. Senator Collins seconds. Passes by unanimous consent.
8. Senator Villarreal motions to vote by unanimous consent. Seconded by Senator Alvarado. Fails.
9. Senator Ramirez motions to vote by roll call. Passes.
10. Senator Ramirez: Point of information to Senator Collins: “Is this bill in response to the 3 specific executive order?”
11. Senator Collins: “Yes.”
12. Motion to vote by roll call. Passed.
13. Senator Villarreal motioned to vote on S2017-R3 by roll call.
 - a. Passed. 29 yes, 1 no, 0 abstain
