



Senate Seat Apportionment Bill - S2017-B-2

WHEREAS the Student Senate shall consist of 45 senators, as is required by the Student Constitution.

WHEREAS each Spring semester, prior to candidate filing for the Elections, the Executive Branch shall present a Bill to the Student Senate outlining the proportionate allocation of Student Senate seats according to the procedure set forth in this Section.

WHEREAS the Executive Branch shall determine the undergraduate student population of the University of North Texas and the undergraduate population of each college, school, or academy of the university.

WHEREAS the Executive Branch shall further determine what percentage of the undergraduate Student Body are members of each college, school, or academy, and calculate the corresponding percentage of the 45 Student Seats shall be assigned to each college, school, or academy. All decimal numbers in actual seat calculation shall be rounded down, unless such rounding would result in less than one whole seat.

WHEREAS in the Fall 2017 semester, the College of Arts and Sciences will be split into two new colleges, The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences (CLASS) and The College of Science (COS)

LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT The next student senate seat apportionment will be compromised of the following: College of Public Affairs & Community Service – 5, College of Business – 7, College of Education – 4, College of Engineering – 4, College of Information – 1, College of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences – 10, College of Music – 1, College of Science – 5, College of Visual Arts & Design – 2, Mayborn School of Journalism – 2, College of Merchandising, Hospitality, & Tourism – 2, Texas Academy of Math & Science – 1, and the Honors College – 1.
