UNT Parent Association Scholarship Applications are OPEN!

The UNT Parent Association awards scholarships in the spring semester each academic year. Two different types of scholarships are awarded—the Scholastic Scholarship and the Draw, or External Scholarship. The number of scholarships given in each category depends on the availability of funds with a minimum of five \$500 scholarships awarded in the Draw category.

The Scholastic Scholarship application deadline is March 1st, 2020.

The Draw/External Scholarship application deadline is April 1st, 2020.

The Spring 2020 installment plan due dates are Feb. 3rd, Mar. 3rd, and Apr. 3rd. Student Financial Services will send an email notification to the UNT email account for students with a payment due. A \$25 late fee will be assessed for any missed installment deadlines.

1098-T forms

2019 1098-T forms will be posted to student accounts in myUNT by January 31st.

Form 1098-T for current and prior year tax returns are available to students on [myUNT](#).

1. Log on to my.unt.edu using your EUID and password.
2. Click on "Student Accounts"
3. Click on "Account Services" on the left tab
4. Click on "View 1098-T"
5. Click on the desired 1098-T tax year to view and print

UNT's Priority Date to complete the **2020-2021** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was January 15, 2020. It's not too late to apply, however! Students and parents should reference **2018** income information when completing this [online](#) application.

The Summer Aid Interest Form became available last week. Students can access this **2 question** form through their [myUNT](#) Student Portal to submit their interest in being awarded [summer](#) financial aid. The Priority Date to complete this form is February 15, 2020.

We encourage all UNT students to complete the General Scholarship Application (GSA) **annually** to be considered for available scholarship opportunities. Students can access the **2020-2021** GSA now by visiting scholarships.unt.edu . Deadlines and eligibility criteria vary for each scholarship.
