Summer Short-Term Loans

Short-term loans for all summer sessions (3W1, 8W1, SUM, 5W1, 10W, 8W2, 5W2) are now available. Short-term loans are intended to help eligible students, needing additional time to finalize payment, pay the amount due for their "current" tuition and fees (it is not available for any past due balances.) Current short-term loans must be paid off prior to taking another short-term loan for future sessions. The loans are awarded for the minimum amount owed for tuition and fees. The loans are posted to the student account in order to pay the entire payment in a summer session.

*A one-time 1% origination fee will be charged at the time of the loan.

Fall 2020 Bills

All tuition and fee charges for the upcoming Fall 2020 semester will be available for viewing in the myUNT student center in mid-July. Once bills are available, your student will receive a welcome letter email to their student email address. There will be important information regarding payment options and next steps to take.

Students can access their student center 24 hours a day, seven days a week. They can view upcoming payment deadlines and amounts due, as well as see pending financial aid awards.

Fall 2020 Payment Deadline

The payment deadline for the Fall 2020 semester has been extended to give students and parents additional time to make payment arrangements. Payments will be due by **Thursday, August 20th at 6pm.**
