Draw Scholarship Applications are still Open!

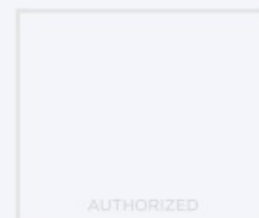

Installment Due Date

The next due date for students on an installment plan is Friday, April 3rd. Students can pay in person with cash, check, or money order. Credit card, debit card, and eCheck payments can be made online in their myUNT student portal.

Tuition Protection Plan

Tuition insurance is a plan that can be purchased by students or their family member who pays for tuition that ensures reimbursement for tuition, room and board, and other fees for covered withdrawals at any time during the semester. An example of a covered withdrawal would be one in which a student must leave due to an unexpected injury or illness.

UNT contracts with GradGuard's™ Tuition Insurance from Allianz Global Assistance. The company offers tuition insurance featuring special plans and rates not available to the general public. Plans also include Student Life Assistance: a 24-hour emergency hotline.

Checks from a 529 Plan

If you use funds from a 529 plan to pay for college expenses, it is important to know that UNT cannot accept checks that are greater than the amount owed on a student account. Please communicate with your student regarding their current balance due. This information is available to students in their myUNT student portal. When requesting check disbursement from your account, please include the student's name and 8-digit student ID number. Please allow 7-10 days for checks to arrive at UNT.

FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act)

FERPA is a federal law that gives certain rights to parents regarding their children's

educational records. These rights transfer to the student upon reaching 18 years of age or attending any school beyond the secondary level (high school).

Parents can have access to education records at UNT only if the student is willing to release information. Students must complete a Student Consent for Release of Records form and return it to the Registrar's Office. The form can be found [here](#).

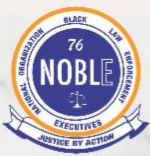
Things you should know...
