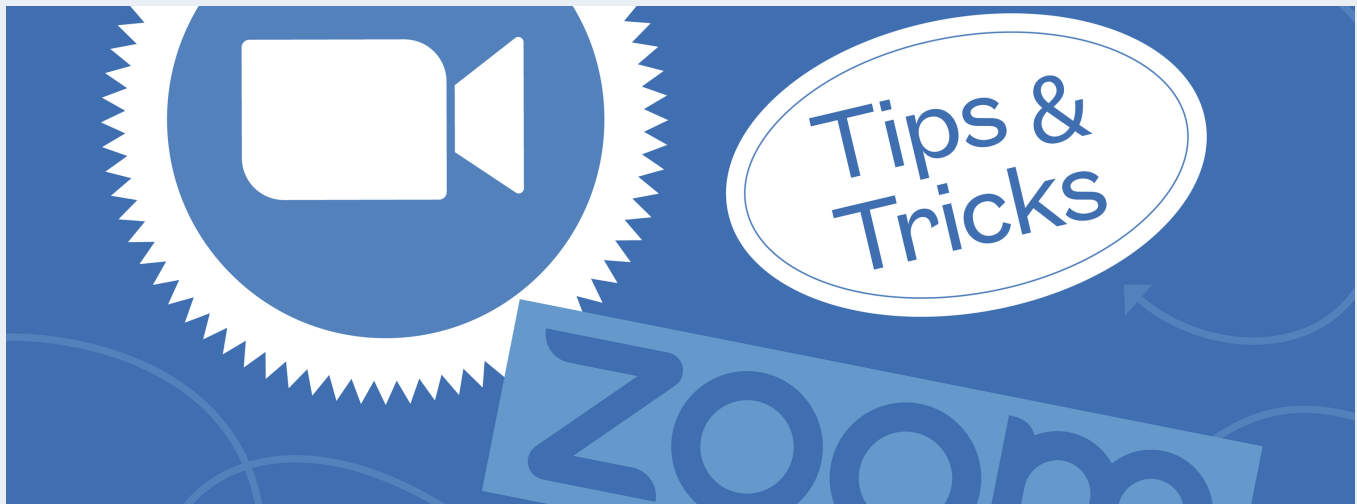


STUDENT ORG CHRONICLES

Virtual Engagement

Navigating how to keep members engaged.

Engage members by planning a new icebreaker for each meeting. This gives each member a chance to speak and members will learn about each other!

Take advantage of the interactive tools that Zoom provides such as breakout rooms, polls, share screen, etc. This helps members to pay attention and interact!

Stay positive- Have a consistent meeting time (whether weekly, monthly, etc.) But also create multiple opportunities for your members to engage with your org. This way if they miss a meeting they can hopefully make the next event.
