

Searching for and contacting an organization

Are you looking to get involved? Finding registered student organizations is simple! To search our list of currently registered organizations, click [here](#). You can search by category (e.g., academic and professional, sport club, religious/spiritual) or name.

Note: If you are not logged in, you will not be able to leave a custom message (as seen below), but you will still be able to contact the organization by providing your name, email address, and selecting a subject.

If you want to see additional information about these orgs, click the blue "Sign In" button in the top right corner [here](#).

Navigate to the *Organizations* tab in the toolbar at the top of your site when you log in. You will be shown all organizations currently registered with Student Activities. From this list, you can search for an organization by name using the search feature. If you aren't sure of the exact organization you are looking for, you can also explore organizations by Organization Category (on the left).


