

Requirements for Obtaining the Privilege to wear Talent Search Graduation Cord

- 1. The Talent Search student must have registered for and taken the ACT/SAT or TSI and report scores to TS Advisor.
- 2. The Talent Search student must have participated in one college fair.
- 3. The Talent Search student must have completed and submitted the FAFSA by February 28th.
- 4. The Talent Search student must have completed and submitted two scholarships.
- 5. The Talent Search student must have applied to one institution of postsecondary education.
- 6. The Talent Search student must have been accepted to one institution of post-secondary education.
- 7. The Talent Search student must have volunteered at least 10 hours of their senior year and submit the proper documentation to verify their participation and a statement about student's experience while volunteering. Must be completed by April 30th.
- 8. The Talent Search student must submit a paragraph to the Talent Search advisor no later than April 30th. The paragraph will explain how Talent Search has helped them and what it would mean for Talent Search to be/remain accessible for future generations.

The Talent Search student must complete all graduation requirements of their current graduation plan. By signing this, I agree I have met the above requirements and I will provide documentation to my Talent Search Advisor by the assigned due date.
